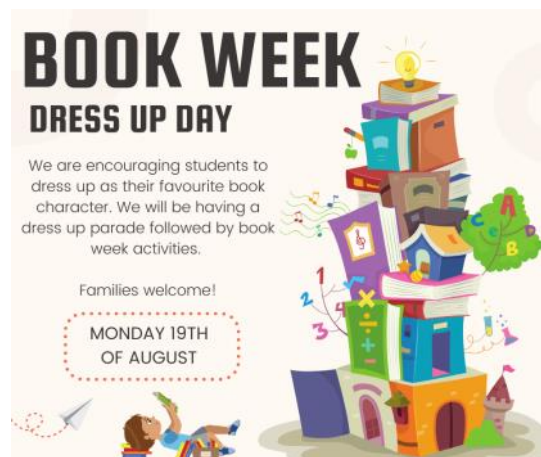

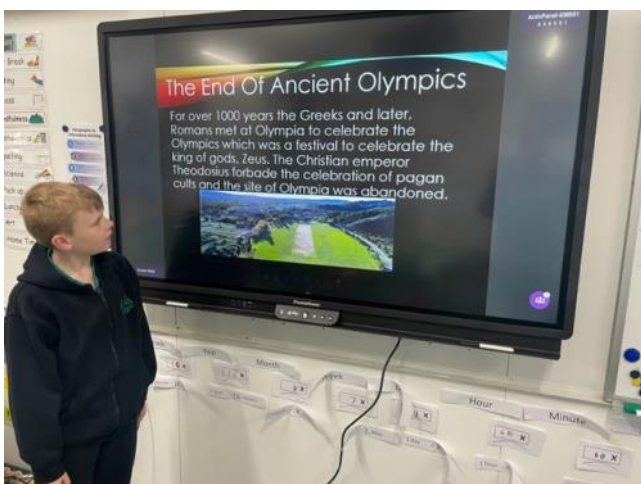
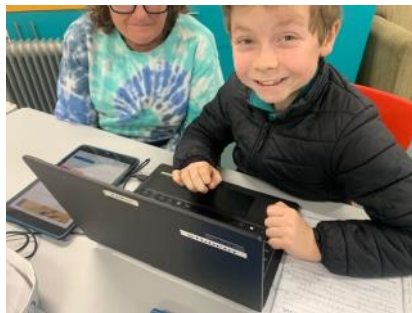

Last week, we were lucky enough to have Ella visit us from the Geelong Gallery as part of the Gallery on Tour program. We learnt all about an artist named Clarice Beckett. Clarice painted a range of open air artworks, wheeling her cart of art supplies around the streets of Beaumaris, painting landscapes and everyday scenes. We studied the way Clarice painted using just the tools she had around her including cereal boxes and paper bags as well as her interesting style of artworks being blurry and not perfect. Students had the opportunity to experiment with tone, colour mixing and working with tools such as sponges to create the blurred effect like Clarice.
